THE OBJECTIVE OF THIS COURSE IS TO LEARN BASIC CONCEPTS OF PLANNING AND OPERATION OF CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS BY THE ARCHITECT, IN ADDITION TO THE COORDINATION AND CONTROL OF PERSONNEL, MATERIALS AND MACHINES, SCHEDULING, ESTIMATION, PURCHASING COST CONTROL, AND OTHER TOPICS. THE INFLUENCE OF CONSTRUCTION PROCEDURES ON DESIGN PROCESSES, IS ALSO INCLUDED IN THE SCOPE.
