2nd Annual International Youth Summit | Developments of the Future: Economics, Tech, and Climate

The Middle East Institute in partnership with Southern Methodist University (SMU) and Howard University (HU) are hosting the second international youth summit, an initiative to bring together university students from the MENA region with a group of American students and MEI interns to discuss common social, political, and cultural topics. The inaugural summit was held throughout the spring and summer of 2021.

This fall, the summit will focus on developments of the MENA future with an emphasis on economics, technology and civil society, and climate change. You will meet with the group of participants on a monthly basis to discuss these issues. The summit sessions will be held on Zoom and will include presentations by content experts, small group discussions moderated by experts based both in MENA and the US, and problem solving among the larger group in search of a greater understanding of these issues, the ways in which they will play out in the Middle East and US, and how the youth can play a role to confront these vital challenges.
