The Middle East Institute in partnership with Southern Methodist University (SMU) and Howard University (HU) are hosting the second international youth summit, an initiative to bring together university students from the MENA region with a group of American students and MEI Interns to discuss common social, political, and cultural topics. The inaugural summit was held throughout the spring and summer of 2021.
