Catalog Data: The main objectives of this course are: This course provides students with an introduction to Digital Forensic Science and the systematic process of acquiring, authenticating and analyzing digital evidence. Students will learn different techniques and procedures that enable them to perform a digital investigation. This course focuses mainly on the analysis of physical storage media, and covers the major phases of digital investigation such as preservation, analysis and acquisition of artifacts that reside in hard disks and random access memory.
